Historic Period and/or Date of Erection: Circa 1900

Historical Significance: This impressive late Victorian structure used to belong to citizens such as Sarah H. Ferguson and Margaret Mercer. It remains an architectural focal point in Camden Township.

Architectural Significance/Description: The turret, slate roof, front entrance, brick work, and asymmetrical design make this an outstanding example of Queen Anne architecture. Edwardian influences can also be seen in the dormer on the front of the building.

Contextual Significance: The home is a landmark as one is driving into the community of Thamesville.
