Proper Placement of Garbage Toter Cart

On your waste collection day, simply place your cart against the curb or edge of pavement (not on sidewalk) and follow the instruction below:

- Place garbage in tied bags or closed boxes only and place inside the cart. Do not place loose garbage in the toter cart which could create litter when the cart is emptied.
- The toter cart lid must be able to close flat to comply with the three (3) bag limit.
- Overloaded carts will not be emptied and becomes the owner's responsibility.
- Arrow on the top of the lid points to the centre of the road.
- Wheels are placed back against the curb or on the edge of the pavement or road.
- Toter carts are placed 1 metre (3 feet) from all stationary objects included other toter carts and recycling boxes.
- Do not place cart under low overhanging tree limbs or utility lines.

Residents are reminded to be mindful of their surroundings when using a toter cart, including the impact of adverse weather conditions such as wind, ice or rain. Please use caution when placing items in the cart and transferring the cart to and from the curb.
