Material Accepted

Reactive

Pool Chemicals
Ammonia, Bleach

Toxic

Pesticides, Rat Poison
Pharmaceuticals, Cleaning Fluids

Fluorescent

Bulbs & Tubes
ONLY

Flammable

Gasoline, Paints
BBQ Starter, Oils, Solvents

Corrosive

Batteries/Acids
Drain Cleaner, Oven Cleaner

Biohazardous

Needles from
residents ONLY

E-Waste

Computers, TV's,
Printers, Cell Phones

- BBQ Propane Tanks (up to 30 pounds only)
- Batteries

Unacceptable

Commercial, industrial, agricultural waste, infectious or radioactive waste, PCB's, explosives (flares or ammunition) propane tanks (>30 pounds), and empty containers will not be accepted.

How

- All material must be in clearly labelled, sealed containers no larger than 20 litres
- Containers will not be returned
- Needles must be delivered in rigid puncture-proof containers (residents only)
- The maximum quantity accepted is a total of 50 litres of waste material
- Stay in your vehicle
- Do not mix different types of material
