

Chatham Leaf & Yard Depot Operating Procedures

Location:

22843 Creek Road, Chatham (south of Park Avenue Business Centre)

Hours of Operation:

January to March:

Tuesday and Thursday from 12:00 – 5:00 pm

Saturday from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm

April to December:

Monday through Friday from 12:00 – 5:00 pm

Saturday from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm

Closed on Statutory Holidays

Acceptable Material:

- Leaf and yard waste is restricted to brush, leaves, grass, yard clippings, and ONLY logs/natural wood 30 inches or less in diameter and no greater than 5 feet in length.

Unacceptable Material:

- Clay/dirt, stumps, sod or dirt/grass mixed, logs greater than 30 inches in diameter and 5 feet in length, food waste/other household organics, faeces, manure, straw, lumber, pressure-treated wood, plywood, railroad ties, garbage and anything else which is not compostable.

Fees:

- All contractors/municipal departments are to be charged \$30.00 per cubic metre or \$2.00 per bag per visit.
- All residents are allowed two cubic metres (25 garbage bags) free of charge per operating day and are to be charged \$5.00 per cubic metre or \$1.00 for each bag over two cubic metres per operating day.
- Christmas trees from residents are free of charge.
- All users must provide proof of residence upon request.

Note: All bags/containers must be emptied on-site, including biodegradable and paper bags. Cardboard boxes must be flattened before placing them in a dumpster. All mulch and wood chips are free of charge to residents when available.

Waste Management encourages all residents in the Municipality Chatham-Kent to participate in diversifying their leaf and yard waste.
