Notice of Public Hearing of Application for Consent

Take notice that the Municipality of Chatham-Kent has received an application for Consent (**File B-92/24**) under Section 53 of the Planning Act, R.S.O.1990, c.P.13, as amended, concerning property located at 1523 5th Concession Line, in Part of Lots 13 and 14, Concession 5, in the Community of Romney (West Kent).

And take further notice that an application under the above file number will be heard by the Committee of Adjustment on the date, and at the time and place shown below:

Purpose and effect: The subject lands are located on the north side of 5th Concession Line, at its northern intersection with Zion Road, in the Community of Romney (Roll Nos. 3650 010 002 34100, 34200 & 34300). The lands are approximately 63.25 ha (156.31 ac.) in area and contain a single detached dwelling, three (3) outbuildings and a wind turbine. The lands are designated Agricultural Area in the Chatham-Kent Official Plan and zoned Agricultural-1 (A1-1).

The application proposes to create a new 0.8 ha (1.9 ac.) residential surplus dwelling lot, containing the existing dwelling (1523 5th Concession Line) and three (3) outbuildings. The retained agricultural parcel will be approximately 62.45 ha (154.41 ac.) in area, contains the wind turbine and will continue to be farmed in the manner it is today.

The Key Map on the reverse indicates the location of the lands affected by the proposed Consent application in relation to other lands within the Municipality.

Any person may attend the hearing and/or make written or verbal representation in support of or in opposition to the proposal.

If a specified person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed Consent, does not make written submissions to the Committee of Adjustment before a decision is made, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Committee of Adjustment in respect to the proposed Consent, you must make written request to the above address.
